

GOLF SOCIETY AUTUMN MEETING 2015

The Society has had some pretty mixed weather this year and even some very wet conditions at its first visit in 2013 to Woking Golf Club. 2015 was completely different with a near cloudless sky all day and a very comfortable mid-teen temperature. The wind blew a bit on a few holes.

Regrettably only 8 members of the Society turned up which made for a very convivial occasion but a bigger attendance would have been nice.



The Associate Salver was won by Chris Mason and the Eric Myer Cup for those with a handicap above 21 was won by Mike Lakin.

The Secretary took full advantage of the benign conditions by winning the President's Cup for the best individual Stableford score, came from behind to win the Golfer of the Year (Geoffrey Woods Cup)(Spring and Autumn scores combined) and joined with Liveryman Mark Savill to win the Voules Cup for the afternoon foursomes competition. Very sensibly and partly due to the excellence of the Woking lunch the afternoon exercise has been reduced from 18 holes to 14 holes and with the additional bonus that the 14th green at Woking is immediately adjacent to the Clubhouse.

The season is not yet over with a triangular match in the first week of October competing against the Fruiterers and the Carmen at Royal Blackheath Golf Club for the Fanmakers Cup (originally presented by Liveryman Frank Stansil). We have not won that for a few years and are hoping to restore former glories. In the first week of November we compete against the Skinners, the Innholders, the Tallow Chandlers, the Turners and the Fuelers for the Dowgate Challenge. We have won this once but it is a much tougher competition to win, especially against the Skinners who seem to have a large pool of high quality golfers.
